103-Gen Meyer Local: No service to Algiers Point (Ferry)

No service along Gen Meyer Ave Bus will service from Semmes St to Willy Terminal.

105-Algiers Local: Buses will not pick up along Holiday Dr and Gen Meyer Ave during the parade.

Check the parade schedule to identify the dates and times of the parades, and the day's transit detours. Use the detour pattern (Uptown, Endymion, etc.) for each parade in the parade table to determine where to board your bus or streetcar. During parades, plan more time for your trip.

General Detour Information

All detours start two hours before a parade begins. Detours will remain in place until parade route is cleared.

Bus service not impacted by parades will be on their regular routes. Remember that increased traffic and pedestrian movements may delay a bus route even if there is no direct impact due to a parade.

Bus and streetcar will operate on a Weekend schedule Mardi Gras day. For additional detour and delay information, visit norta.com/mardigras.

12-St. Charles Streetcar

During Mardi Gras season, from February 21 - March 4, streetcar service will only operate from S Carrollton & S Claiborne to St Charles & Napoleon.

A service change will start again from February 21 through Mardi Gras Day and will also operate from S Carrollton & S Claiborne to St Charles & Napoleon. The last streetcar traveling downtown will leave St Charles and Napoleon at 3:00pm until the parade clears St Charles Ave. A bus shuttle will be provided for services on the St. Charles line. Shuttle bus services will operate from St Charles & Valence St to Loyola & Common. The shuttle will operate outbound from Loyola & Common to St Charles & Valence.

Regular St Charles streetcar service will resume Wednesday, March 5 at 5:00am.

46-UPT/Rampart Streetcar

Streetcar service is dependent on parade and route.

47-Canal-Cemeteries Streetcar
48-Canal-City Park/Museum Streetcar

During parade season, the 47 streetcar will provide service from the Cemeteries Transit Center to Canal & LaSalle (Liberty).

The 48 will travel between City Park and Canal & LaSalle (Liberty).

There will be no streetcar service from Canal & LaSalle (Liberty) to Canal St Ferry Terminal until parades have cleared Canal St.

49-UPT/Riverfront Streetcar

Streetcar service will only operate from Canal St Ferry Terminal to the French Market. Starting Thursday, February 27, all Canal streetcar services will be replaced with buses. Service will end completely at noon on Saturday. Regular streetcar service will return Sunday, March 2.


Fares and Passes

Fares are available for purchase on the Le Pass app (norta.com/lepass), in person at the RTA's Canal St facility located at 2817 Canal St between 8:30 AM-4:30 PM, and online for delivery at norta.com/store. Passes are also available at select metro-area Walgreens stores. See norta.com/retailers for locations.

Cash Change

Bus and streetcar fareboxes accept up to a \$20 bill or RTA tokens and only provide change with an RTA change card good for future rides on RTA. No cash refunds or cash change is available on any of the RTA modes. RTA highly encourages the use of the Le Pass app or Transit app for purchasing passes and fares for all modes.

Uptown Parades

Streetcar Detours

12-St. Charles Streetcar: Travel toward downtown will end at Valance & St Charles and return uptown from there. Shuttle will transport riders the rest of the way downtown.

47/48-Canal Streetcar: Service will end at LaSalle (Liberty). No service from LaSalle to Canal St Ferry Terminal.

49-UPT/Riverfront: This service will run from Canal St Ferry Terminal to French Market.

Bus Detours

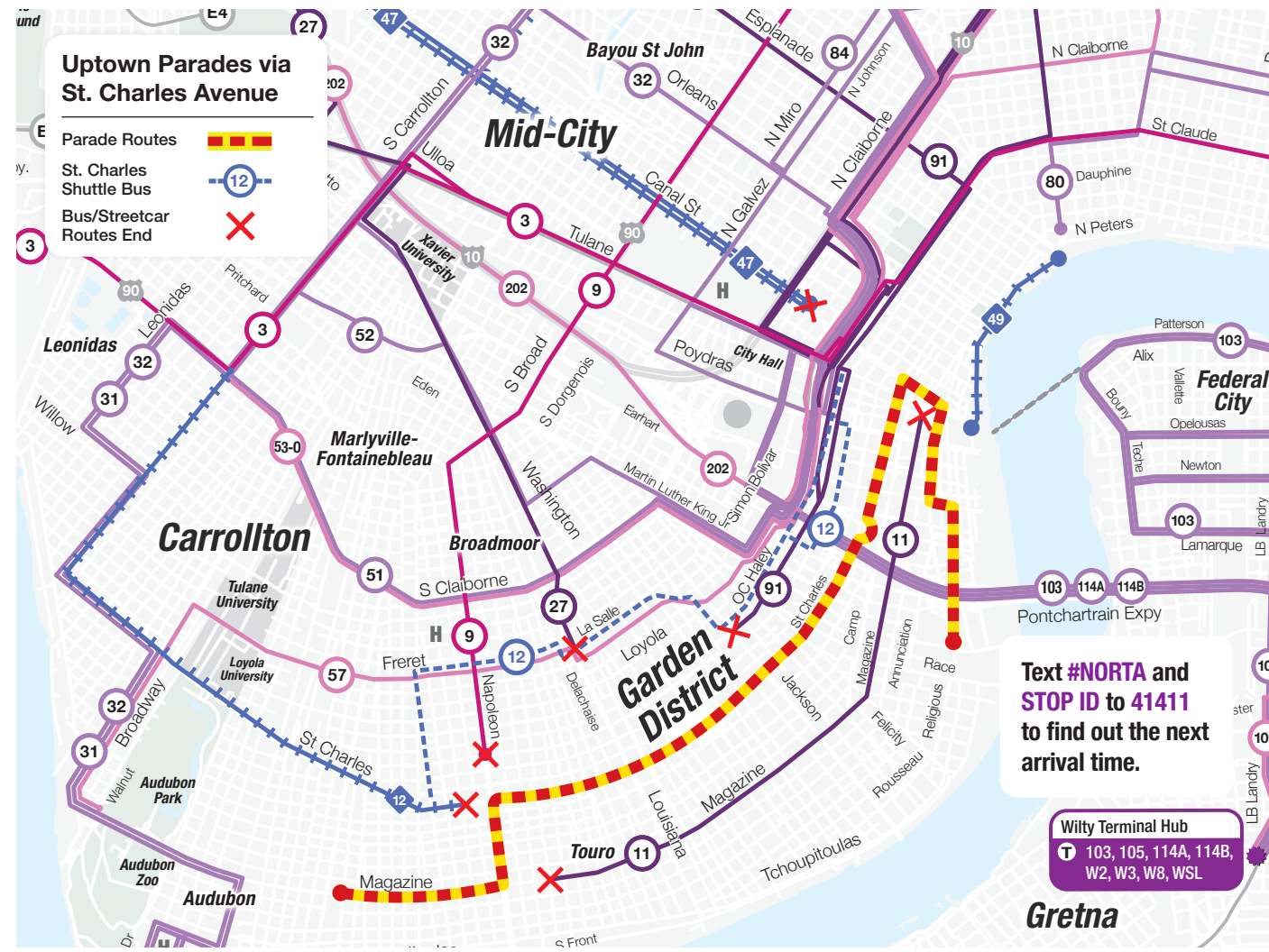
9-Broad/Napoleon: Service will terminate at Dryades S. No service south of Baronne to Tchoupitoulas St

11-Magazine: Service will end at Marengo when headed Uptown (outbound).
When headed Downtown (inbound), service will terminate at Camp St and Poydras St. No service from Poydras to Main Library Hub to Canal St.

27-Louisiana: Service will terminate at LaSalle St and Louisiana Ave No service south of Loyola Ave to Tchoupitoulas St (Walmart).

91-Jackson/Esplanade: Service will end at Simon Bolivar and Jackson Ave (inbound). No service between Simon Bolivar and Walmart.

French Quarter & Marigny Parades

Krewe of Chewbacchus Saturday, February 1 at 7:00 pm

8-St. Claude-Arabi & 80-Desire-Louisa: No service on St Claude Ave and Elysian Fields Ave to the river until the parade clears. Buses will detour using N Claiborne Ave corridor until the parade clears.

Krewe Bohème Friday, February 14 at 7:00 pm

Expect service delays during the parade on the **8-St. Claude-Arabi, 55-Elysian Fields, 80-Desire-Louisa and 91-Jackson-Esplanade.**

8-St. Claude-Arabi and 55-Elysian Fields: Traveling away from downtown (outbound), buses will detour away from Rampart, instead taking Basin to N Claiborne. They will take a right at N Claiborne and St Bernard and resume regular routes at Rampart/St Claude.

80-Desire-Louisa: Traveling toward the river (inbound), the route will end at Elysian Fields & N Rampart. Traveling outbound, bus will take

St Claude from Elysian Fields & N Rampart to regular route.

91-Jackson-Esplanade: Traveling to Cemeteries (outbound), bus will detour away from Rampart, instead taking Basin to N Claiborne to Esplanade Ave, resuming regular route.

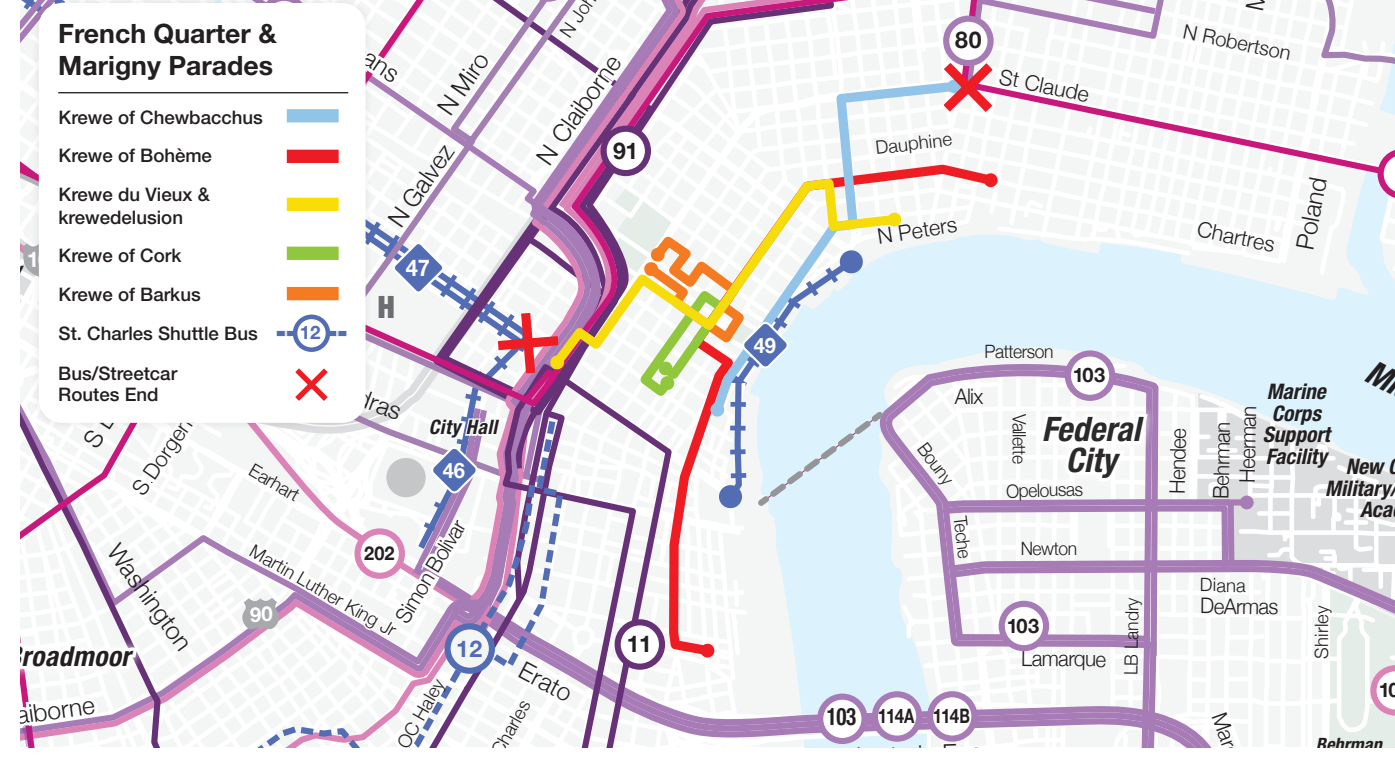
46-UPT/Rampart: Streetcars will run between Union Passenger Terminal (UPT) and Canal at LaSalle.

47/48-Canal Streetcars: Streetcars will terminate at LaSalle (Liberty). No streetcar service below Bourbon to the river along Canal St.

49-UPT/Riverfront: Service will run from Canal St Ferry Terminal to French Market.

80-Desire-Louisa: Buses will terminate at Elysian Fields and St Claude. No service south of St Claude Ave to Decatur.

Streetcar Detours

12-St. Charles Streetcar: Travel toward downtown will end at Valance & St Charles and return uptown from there. Shuttle will transport riders the rest of the way downtown.

46-UPT/Rampart Streetcar: Will not operate.

47/48-Canal Streetcars: Starting Thursday, February 27, all Canal streetcar services will be replaced with buses. Service will end completely at noon on Saturday. Regular streetcar service will return Sunday, March 2.

49-UPT/Riverfront Streetcar: Streetcar will service from French Market to Canal St Ferry Terminal beginning at 5am until parade clears from Canal St zone.

3-Tulane/Elmwood: Regular route until 3pm. After 3, route will end downtown at LaSalle & Tulane Ave Bus will leave downtown taking Gravier to N Claiborne to regular route.

8-St. Claude: Regular route until 3pm. After 3, the route to downtown will end at Iberville. The bus will leave downtown taking a U-turn to N Rampart to the regular route.

9-Broad/Napoleon: Early parade: No service from Baronne to Tchoupitoulas. Evening parade:

Shuttle service will operate from Napoleon & Tchoupitoulas to Banks & S Broad. Bus service on the downtown side of Canal will operate from Bienville St and N Broad until the parade clears Broad Ave & Canal.

11-Magazine: Will end at Camp and Poydras.

27-Louisiana: There will be no service from Delgado Community College to the Cemeteries Transit Center. The bus will end at the Cemeteries Transit Center

55-Elysian Fields: Regular route until 3pm. Buses will service to Iberville St at N Rampart. No service from Iberville to Main Library Hub

61/62-Lake Forest/Morrison: Regular route until 3pm. Then the route will end downtown at Basin and Iberville and begin an outbound trip from there.

84-Galvez: Regular service to 3pm. Buses from Lower 9th Ward will end at N Galvez St and Bienville St. Buses will travel outbound from Bienville St to Esplanade.

103-General Meyer and 114/114B-Garden Oaks-Sullen/Woodland: Regular service to 3pm. Then, traveling to downtown, buses will take I-10 to Claiborne Ave exit, right on Tulane Ave to Main Library. Outbound bus will reverse inbound route.

202-Airport: Route will start and end at Union Passenger Terminal (UPT) on Loyola.

Split Routes

Routes 31 and 32 will be divided into two sections by parades – an Uptown and Downtown section. Each section will run independently with the below detours:

Downtown: Buses will service from Gently Walmart to Beaugard Circle.

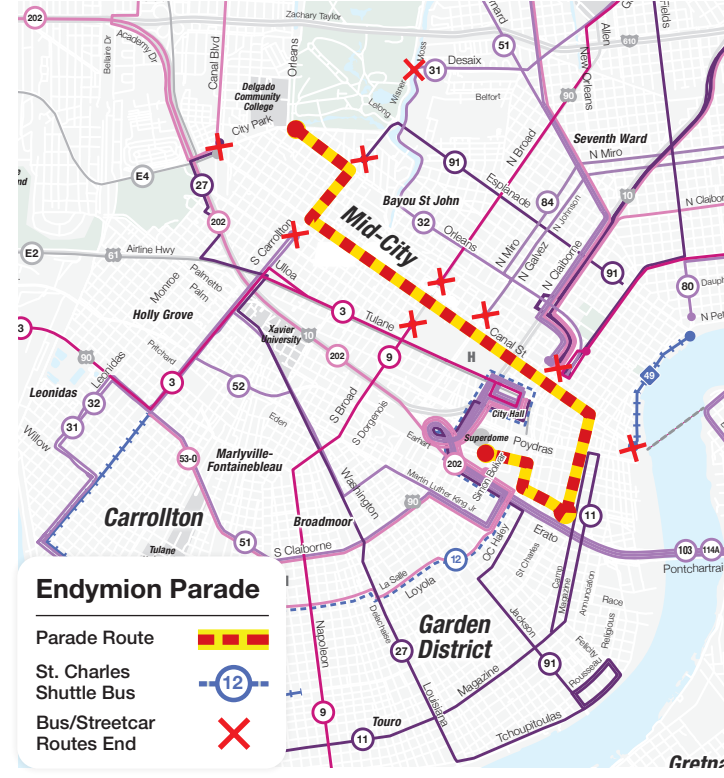
Uptown: Buses stop at Carrollton and Banks.

Routes 51, 52, 57 and 91 will be divided into two sections by parades – an Uptown and Downtown section. Each section will run independently with the below detours:

Downtown: Buses will service to Basin at Iberville.

Uptown: Buses will stop at Main Library (Loyola & Common). They will not service other stops in the CBD.

Streetcar Detours

12-St. Charles Streetcar: Travel toward downtown will end at Valance & St Charles. Streetcar will return uptown from there.

47/48-Canal Streetcars: Streetcars will not service from LaSalle (Liberty) to the River until the parade passes.

49-UPT/Riverfront Streetcar: Service from French Market to Canal St Ferry Terminal beginning at 5am until parade clears from Canal St zone.

3-Tulane/Elmwood: Route will end downtown at LaSalle & Tulane Ave. Bus will leave downtown taking Gravier to N Claiborne to regular route.

8-St. Claude/Arabi: Route will end at N Rampart & Conti.

9-Broad/Napoleon: Stops between Esplanade Ave and Canal St will not be

serviced during the parades. Uptown: No service from Baronne to Tchoupitoulas until parade passes.

11-Magazine: Route will end at Camp & Poydras. No service to Main Library Hub or Canal St.

27-Louisiana: Route will end at Louisiana & LaSalle.

32-Leonidas/Treme: Buses will turn around at Moss St starting at 8am until parade clears.

51/52-St. Bernard-Claiborne/Paris-Broadmoor: No buses on the Uptown side starting at 6am. Downtown buses will end route at N Rampart & Bienville.

55-Elysian Fields: No service from Basin and Bienville to Main Library Hub until parade passes. Route will end at N Rampart & Conti

57-Franklin/Freret: No service on the Uptown side starting at 6am. Downtown buses: No service on Claiborne to the Main Library Hub. Route will end at N

Mardi Gras Day Parades

61 & 62-Lake Forest/Morrison: East buses will not service Basin to Main Library Hub until parade passes. Route will end at N Rampart & Conti.

84-Galvez: No service between Esplanade Ave and Poydras St. Route will end at N Rampart & Conti.

91-Jackson/Esplanade: No Uptown bus service. No service to Canal St until parade passes.

103-Gen. Meyer Local: Buses will not access Main Library Hub until parade passes. Route will end at Tulane & LaSalle.

114A/114B-Garden Oaks-Sullen/Woodland: Buses will not access Main Library Hub until parade passes. Route will end at Tulane & LaSalle.

202-Airport: Route will start and end at Union Passenger Terminal (UPT) on Loyola.
