

## **Top Responses:**

### **Algiers Terminal today**

- Poor information and signage
- Lacks public restrooms
- No ADA access to ferry
- Lack of commercial uses
- Limited parking

- Retail/Concessionaire opportunities
- Performance/Event /Community Space
- Public Restrooms
- Public Art/Exhibits








## Site and Circulation – Opportunity Zones






## Site and Circulation – Circulation Diagram


## Pedestrian Boarding – West Elevation


## Pedestrian Boarding – 3D View



## Cross Section – Covered Pedestrian Ferry Boarding




