



DEFINING BRT

THINK RAIL, USE BUSES


Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) is a highquality bus-based transit system that delivers <u>fast and efficient service</u> that **may** include:

- Dedicated lanes
- Traffic signal priority
- Off-board fare collection
- Elevated platforms
- Enhanced stations
- Unique vehicles

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WHY BRT FOR NEW ORLEANS?

EQUITY IN TRANSPORTATION

Opportunity for economic mobility is significantly limited without high-quality transit in New Orleans

Driving vs transit access disparity has <u>disproportionate</u> impact to people of color



Average time to work (min) in Orleans Parish

Auto-dependency is a significant <u>cost-burden</u> to households




Job Concentration and Bus Rapid Transit Corridor ORLEANS 34,000+ people 45,000+ jobs

INVESTING IN TRANSIT

Of 50 Largest U.S. metros, is New Orleans is one of 7 WITHOUT high-capacity "rapid" transit






IMPROVE KEY EXISTING TRIPS

BRT will significantly improve existing transit trips for high ridership areas

RTA has high ridership on lines serving New Orleans East and Algiers.

For these transit riders, BRT will offer shorter, more frequent and more reliable trips.

TRANSIT PRIORITY

BRT is a new way to travel with public transportation, offering trips that are similar to or better than driving.

PM Rush Hour: New Orleans East (Lake Forest/Read) to Downtown (Canal & Basin)



Driving Today:

 $30 - 60 \, \text{min}$

Bus Today:

40 – 90 min

50 min avg



BRT Dedicated Lanes:

45 min

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

High quality Rapid Transit has proven to attract real estate investment and revitalize communities

Recent study found BRT projects with dedicated lanes resulted in:

- 33% increase office space
- 50% increase workforce housing development

CASE STUDIES:

Cleveland Healthline

- \$9.5 Billion in economic development
- 23 million square feet in total development
- 13,000 new jobs

Albuquerque Rapid Transit

- \$2.9 Billion in economic development
- \$418 Million in increased assessed property value
- 9,592 new jobs












Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA)

Adopting a Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA) sets the "where" for the BRT Route only. Community engagement will expand during design process.











- New value to vacant buildings




OVERALL SCHEDULE

Key Questions to Be Answered in Next Phase (Design)

We Are Here

What are the full range of benefits of dedicated transitway?

- Commuting
- School transportation
- Land value and investment potential
- Workforce attraction / retention
- What are the impacts to traffic and travel time?
 (by time of day and day of the week)
- How significant are those impacts to the community?
- Do the benefits outweigh the costs?
- What are the community preferences for street and station design?
